Shenzhen is located in the southern portion of the Guangdong Province, on the eastern shore of the Pearl River Delta neighboring Hong Kong. In 1980 it became the first Special Economic Zone of China and from then the city has been renowned for its rapid economic growth and business and industrial zones and parks.

PORTS OF ENTRY TO SHENZHEN

AIR: Bao' An International Airport is China's 4th largest airport by passenger volume. Hong Kong International Airport provides a second point of entry by air with direct connections by ferry and a 1.5 - 2 hour journey by road including customs control.

RAIL: Trains from Hong Kong and most other major China cities enter into Hui Zhan Zhong Station, Shenzhen.

SEA: Direct Ferries from Shenzhen connect the city with Hong Kong International Airport & Macau.
